

1. Project Description Describe/show to what degree the project was carried out as planned. Include what went well and what proved to be a challenge. Include a synthesis of your journal entries.

The main component of the project was in general carried out as planned. We worked on, based on the provided curriculum guide from MELS, the necessary resources to teach this new program.

Our school started this program later in the school year in order to allow us to get prepared with program as we did not have the necessary resources /textbook for our students. We semestered the course from February to June which allow us to have approximately 45 teaching blocks to cover all four main chapters. As mentioned, we created the resources, projects, notes, etc. to teach this new course and to accomplish the learning outcomes of this program.

WWW: We got to learned to the curriculum /program much better. We had time to collaborate on this new program. We received the English version textbook which used as guide. We mainly used the program on Learn Quebec in order to create the PowerPoints, assignments and some for assessments (project, quizzes, presentations, etc.).

Challenge: We received the program curriculum from MELS which was not as detailed as we would have to like. Since this is not our teachable and that we were not previously trained in the transition, this has been a challenge. Also, we only received the MELS approved textbook (Making Sense of Finance) by Chenelières at the end f term 1. It is important to mention that we did not have the teacher's guide; we will need to purchase it for the next school year. We needed to supplement our curriculum with external resources.

We strongly believe that this 2 credits content based class has too much information to be covered adequately in the allocated timeframe. In order to keep the students motivated and understand the finance, this class should be possibly semester; this a challenge has our school has 3 terms. Lastly, the textbook is very dense and is, at times, hard to filter the main elements.

We believed that we have met our goals were meet:

- a) Establish a curriculum pacing guide;
- b) Create class lesson notes (i.e. PowerPoints);
